Eligibility Criteria	<p>To be eligible to receive the CQUniCares Santos GLNG Herb Cordero Memorial Scholarship, an applicant must meet the following criteria:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Be enrolled or intending to enrol at CQUniversity in Term 1, 2023; ▪ Be studying internally at CQUniversity Gladstone Marina campus or be studying online while permanently resident in the Gladstone Region Local Government Area; ▪ Be studying an undergraduate or postgraduate degree in a Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics (STEM) or business discipline; ▪ Be an Australian Citizen, Permanent Resident, holder of a Humanitarian Visa or New Zealand Citizen with a permanent home address in Australia; ▪ Be enrolled at Census Date in Term 1, 2023; ▪ Not be receiving multiple CQUniversity Scholarships that exceed the annual value of \$10,000.

	<p>*Payments may continue to be awarded on a pro rata basis to students completing less than 12 credit points in extenuating circumstances. This is at the discretion of both the Student Scholarships Team and GLNG Operations Pty Ltd (Santos GLNG).</p>
<p>Selection Criteria</p>	<p>Applicants will be assessed on the application and a written submission of no more than 250 words addressing the following:</p> <p>"How will a CQUniversity Scholarship assist with your studies?"</p>
<p>Supporting Documentation</p>	<p>*Disclaimer - Students may be required to provide further documentation to support their application. This can include the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Written submission • Documentation demonstrating academic achievement or unofficial transcript • Documentation demonstrating community involvement, exemplary work or demonstration of leadership • Resume • Documentation demonstrating low personal or family income/ financial need • Confirmation of Identity or 2 x Cultural References + a Statutory Declaration (if relevant to scholarship) <p>All requests for further information to support applications will be sent to the student email account. Failure to supply further information will deem the application incomplete and will not be considered.</p>
<p>Additional Information and Ongoing Eligibility Requirements</p>	<p>Expectations of Recipients</p> <p>As a scholarship recipient, you will be asked to participate in a feedback survey. You may also be approached to assist with positively promoting CQUniversity's Scholarship program by sharing your experiences as a recipient through media or invited to attend events such as Orientation or Open Days. If you do not wish to be publicly recognised or be involved in the above initiatives, please advise the Advancement and Alumni Relations Team via ourpartners@cqu.edu.au immediately following acceptance.</p> <p>CQUniversity has a range of support services located on our website Student Support Services and Financial Preparedness.</p> <p>Ongoing Eligibility Requirements</p> <p>In addition to the eligibility criteria, the successful applicant must:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Maintain a minimum GPA of 4.0 each term ▪ Remain enrolled in the course as at Term 2 Census Date with a study load of 12 credit points or more. <p>Please note that failure to meet the continuing eligibility criteria may result in the scholarship being cancelled.</p>

	<p>Additional Information</p> <p>Students may request a deferral of their scholarship in special circumstances. This request must be made through the Student Scholarships Team and should occur in conjunction with an official Leave of Absence request to the University. If approved, a scholarship may only be deferred for a maximum period of two terms (excludes Term 3). Continuing students must still maintain a minimum GPA of 4.0 in the term directly before taking a Leave of Absence.</p> <p>In special circumstances, a student may also make a request to transfer their scholarship to an alternative course of study. This request must be through the Student Scholarships Team and is at the discretion of the scholarship donor.</p> <p>Sharing details with the Donor of your scholarship</p> <p>As funds for your scholarship have been generously donated, CQUniversity is required to share your name, course/ study area and ongoing eligibility (including academic performance) with the donor of your scholarship. Donors may wish to celebrate their recipients, however if you do not wish your donor or CQUniversity to promote your name publicly, this can be arranged.</p> <p>Thanking your donor</p> <p>Many of our scholarships are made possible by generous donations from community partners who are committed to supporting CQUniversity students to reach their academic goals. <p>Selection Process</p>	<p>A section panel, consisting of representatives from GLNG Operations Pty Ltd (Santos GLNG) will be formed to determine the successful applicant.</p> <p>Scholarships at CQUniversity are highly competitive. All applications are ranked based on how well applicants address the selection criteria, and in comparison, to other applicants.</p>

	<p>Being eligible or being a recipient in the past is no guarantee of having a successful application.</p> <p>A scholarship will only be offered where there is an applicant of sufficient merit.</p> <p>All applicants are advised that any request for further information to support their application will be sent to their student email accounts or nominated email account for future students. Students will be required to re-submit any further information requested through their original application in MyCQU. Failure to resubmit further information will deem the application incomplete and will not be considered.</p> <p>The Student Scholarships Team are unable to provide updates to students on the progress of their individual application until all assessments are completed.</p> <p>Students will be notified of the outcome of their application via their student email accounts only. Decisions are final.</p>
<p>Payment of Scholarship</p>	<p>The successful applicant is required to enter their current financial institution details (banking details) into their MyCQU for payment to occur. This must be done prior to Term 1 Census Date to avoid delays.</p> <p>Payments are based on term study loads as follows:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ <i>\$1,250 /term for study load of 12 credit points</i> ▪ <i>\$2,500 /term for study load of 18 credit points or more</i> <p>Payment will be made to the successful applicant in Week 6 after final post Census Date eligibility checks each term.</p> <p>Payments will be credited electronically to the student’s nominated bank account.</p>
